Language Arts:

Grammar:

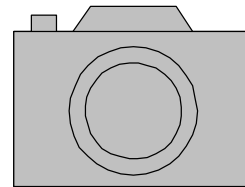
We will be learning about adverbs. We will also be reviewing punctuation and capitalization.

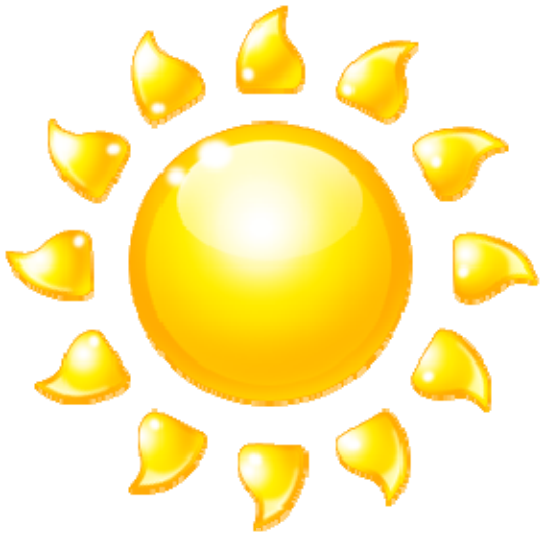
